Behavioral Agreement (Required for each guest) MDHSA High School Formal

I _____ agree to adhere by the following rules while attending the MDHSA High School Formal.

- *Attendees are expected to show respect and courtesy to all chaperones and other attendees.
- *Attendees are expected to show respect for the property and facility by doing no damage.
- *No tobacco products, alcohol, drugs or other illegal substances will be permitted.
- *Anyone found disregarding these rules will be asked to leave immediately.

In requesting music pieces, I will adhere to the MDHSA music policy which states in part: "...the Executive Committee is proposing that certain music not be played at formals in the future, which includes music requested by students at the formal. Music that should not be played includes that which mentions drugs, alcohol, sex, violence and unacceptable language. With this, it should be understood that certain discretion should be used by chaperones in enforcing this policy. By this we mean that there may be certain appropriate exceptions to this policy. For example, a song that speaks of someone who, through redemption, no longer is doing drugs or alcohol and has chosen a new path may be acceptable. This policy permits secular music as well as Christian music as long as it fits the above criteria." By signing below, I understand these rules and the consequences for disregarding them.
